Notes for DIY face mask pattern:

*when cutting out pattern pieces, make sure you mark the TOP from the BOTTOM as shown-it does make a difference when piecing together and for wearing.

1/4" seam allowance is used to sew the entire pattern.

*cutting elastic pieces 15" long gives you room to adjust to the size you need when you mask is done.

*pattern may not be sold. You may use this pattern to make masks to sell or gift.

If you aren't able to find elastic cording, you can also use 1/4" elastic. Also try hair ties, bias tape to construct a tie strap, drawstring cording or larger diameter shoes laces.

PRINTING:

Make sure when your print you pattern off, that it's printing at 100%
